MAPPING

Introduction

A conversion has been made of the ISO 9999 classes on the third level (or on the second level whenever a third level is lacking) to ICF classes, according to the product related intended use of the assistive products within that class.¹

Product related intended use is an intrinsic characteristic of assistive products which indicates what the user of the assistive product can and may expect of the assistive product. It does not describe the user, but the product itself! The product related intended use of an assistive product to help blind people in their communication is 'communication' and not '(an impairment in) seeing functions'.

The product related intended use can be further specified in:

the functionality of the assistive product: activities (and indirectly participation) for/in which the assistive product can be used (e.g. standing, work) and functions and structures which are supported by the assistive product (e.g. respiration, muscle power, balance). The functionality can be described with terms from the ICF. This is what has be done in this report.

Other characteristics of product related intended use, which can not be described by ICF are:

- * technical capacities of the assistive products
- * user friendliness and comfort of the assistive product
- * the looks of the assistive product
- * other characteristics (like maintenance)

¹ Excluded are accessories and parts (e.g. knee units and liners as part of prostheses); these classes are included in the document, but no conversion to ICF is made as these products are not used on their own.





Mapping categories

1

To indicate the functionality, the different assistive products are subdivided into five categories:

Assistive products which primarily support a function Assistive products that <u>support a function</u>, but are not used as such in the performance of an activity. An example are nebulizers and oxygen units. The availability of these

assistive products is a prerequisite for the performance of activities and participation (but are not used as such in the performance). Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the *function*

posal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the *function* involved and and/or to a *general activity* (such as d5702 Maintaining one's health)

2 Assistive products which primarily enable the performance of activities

Assistive products that <u>support a function or anatomical structure</u> and <u>are used in the</u> <u>performance of an activity</u>: e.g. a knee orthosis (ameliorates alignment and promotes stability and is used in walking). In this way the assistive products can also be a prerequisite for participation.

Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the *function/structure* involved and/or to the *(most primary) activity* that is performed

This category also encompass assistive products that are primarily meant to be used in the performance of activities. However many of these assistive products do support one or more functions. E.g. walking aids are meant for walking but they also support balance and gait pattern.

Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the *function/structure* involved and/or to the (*most primary*) *activity* that is performed

This category also encompass assistive products that are primarily meant to be used in the performance of activity. However these products also support an activity. E.g. raised toilet seats are used in toileting and they support sitting down and standing. Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the **activity**

involved and to the *(most primary) activity* that is performed

Remark: A disadvantage of this mapping is that there are two kinds of activities: activities which are supported by the product and activities which are being done using the assistive product; the difference between the two can not derived from the list with codes (see e.g. 09.12.12).

Assistive products which are a prerequisite for participation

Assistive products that <u>are a substitute for a function/structure</u>, may <u>support a function</u>, are not used in the performance of an activity, but can be seen as <u>a prerequisite for</u> <u>participation</u>. For instance a wig can be seen as a necessary product during participation in work for a woman with loss of hair after chemotherapy treatment. Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the **specific function(s)/structure** involved and/or to the **(most primary) domain of participation** (such as work, family)





This category also encompass assistive products that <u>protect a function/structure</u> and are primarily meant to <u>be used in participation</u>. For instance caps; they do not contribute to the performance of an activity, but they make it possible e.g. that children with a specific motor impairment (coordination) can play together with peers by protecting the neck/head against traumatic lesions.

Proposal: for these assistive products a mapping can be made to **the** function/structure involved and/or **the specific domain of** participation

Assistive products which are primarily used for training.

These products can be subdivided in:

- a products that are used for training functions
 Proposal: for these products a mapping is made to *the function that's being trained*
- products that are used for training activities
 Proposal: for these products a mapping is made to *the activity that's being trained*

Assistive products which are primarily used for measuring (or controlling) functioning or environmental/ personal factor

Assistive products that <u>are used to measure (or control) a function, a structure, the</u> <u>performance of an activity (or indirect participation) or an environmental or personal</u> <u>factor</u>. If relevant the activity can be coded during which the product is used (e.g. a bath thermometer is used during bathing) or a more general activity such as looking after one's health.

Proposal for these assistive products a mapping can be made to the function/structure, activity/domain of participation, environmental factor or personal factor that is measured (controlled) and/or to the (most primary) activity that is performed

Remark: A disadvantage of this mapping is that there are two kinds of activities: activities which are measured by the product and activities which are being done using the assistive product; the difference between the two can not derived from the list with codes (see e.g. 09.12.12).

Subject of debate: Is it not always possible to make a mapping to the environmental factor that is measured (controlled), especially in those cases that the description of what is being measured is global, e.g. 27.06.12 Assistive products and tools for measuring mass (not of person)

In the conversion we have used block titles, but we avoided 8 and 9 classes. Accessories and components of prostheses are not coded.
